

REQUIRED PUBLIC DISCLOSURE FOR ACO PARTICIPATION WAIVER

COASTAL PLAINS NETWORK, LLC

The Secretary of U.S. Department of Health and Human Services has made available waivers of certain federal laws to Accountable Care Organizations (“ACOs”) participating in the Medicare Shared Savings Program (“MSSP”). To avail itself of these waivers, Coastal Plains Network, LLC (“Coastal Plains Network”) is obligated to publically disclose certain arrangements, which are described below.

Coastal Plains Network hereby publically discloses the following program to assist in patient joint preservation (“Joint Preservation Program”). The ACO’s Board of Directors (the “Board”) has reviewed this arrangement and has made a *bona fide* determination, consistent with the Board members’ duties, that the arrangement is reasonably related to the purposes of MSSP as, among other MSSP goals, the arrangement will facilitate improved care for individuals, better health for populations, and reduced expenditures for Medicare, consistent with the goals and contractual obligations of the MSSP.

- Under the terms of the arrangement, beginning on January 8, 2018 ACO participants, including but not limited to, Vidant Edgecombe Hospital (“VEDG”), may provide services free of charge to ACO beneficiaries and other patients in the form of a multi-week program consisting of exercise, nutrition, and behavioral education, monitoring, and training. The goal of the Joint Preservation Program is to restore normal and pain-free function of major joints without joint replacement, improve population health, assist in patient adherence to care plans, and achieve the goals of the MSSP by enhancing the quality, efficacy, safety, and cost of services provided to Medicare beneficiaries. Certain ACO participants may incur a potential benefit, which could potentially constitute remuneration, resulting from their ability to make the Joint Preservation Program available to their patients at no cost.
